SUBMISSION OF 2023 RPS REPORTORIAL REQUIREMENT

In compliance with the RPS On-Grid Rules, Mandated Participants are hereby directed to prepare and submit their respective 2023 RPS Requirement and Compliance Form (RPS Form) using actual data sets for period 2018-2022 and projections for planning period 2023-2032.

The 2023 RPS Form integrated the following updates: Annual Incremental Renewable Energy (RE) Percentage (K<sub>m</sub>) at 1% for period 2018-2022 and 2.52% for period 2023-2032; potential RE Certificate allocations from the first round of the Green Energy Auction Program (GEAP); and actual generation of RE power plants under the Feed-in-Tariff scheme for year 2022 and projections for period 2023-2025.

In view of the foregoing, we enjoin all Mandated Participants to submit their individual 2023 RPS Requirement and Compliance Forms. Kindly submit the following via electronic mail to rps\_remb@doe.gov.ph not later than **01 August 2023**:

- 1. Actual data sets for period 2018-2022 and projections for planning period 2023-2032:
  - a. Net Electricity Sales, (less own-use);
  - Generation under Net-Metering Agreements, those installed within the premises of the end-users, under the Green Energy Option Program, and from the first round of GEAP, if applicable; and
  - c. Supply Contract details.
- Duly accomplished and signed copy (in PDF) of the 2023 RPS Form, attached hereto as Annex "A". Ensure all data entries are consistent with your respective 2023 Distribution Development Plan submissions; and
- Affidavit executed by the General Manager or any officer of equivalent rank to attest to the truthfulness and veracity of all data sets and information indicated in the 2023 RPS Form.

Failure to comply with this directive may result in applicable liabilities under Section 36 of the Republic Act No. 9513 and Sections 23 and 24 of the DC2017-12-0015<sup>1</sup>.

Please be guided accordingly.
